## Statement

- The decision to close the facilities based on inclement weather is challenging. The club employees and membership base spans a large geographical area. As such, difficult travel for one does not mean difficult travel for all.
- 2. Members must make their own driving decisions based on local conditions and there comfort level. Most importantly, one must stay SAFE. In inclement weather allow extra time and exercise caution.

## A. Unforeseen Circumstances

- 1. The facilities may be closed for unforeseen circumstance beyond our control or inclement weather. Unfortunately, make-up classes are not granted.
- 2. The respective managers will collectively determine gym closures and delegate information dissemination.
- 3. Gym closure for inclement weather consideration will be based on time of day and projected weather forecast throughout the day.
- 4. Factors influencing the decision will include:
  - a) Halton District Public School Board and the Halton District Catholic School Board
  - b) Local and Provincial Police advisories
  - c) City of Burlington
- 5. When a decision has been made to close the facilities, information will be immediately posted by the delegate(s) via:
  - a) Voicemail message at both gyms both lines
  - b) Burlington Gymnastics Club GC Website/Facebook/Twitter/Instagram
  - c) Email Competitive and Recreation Program
  - d) Parent Representative communication
  - e) CHML (AM 900) Radio and Website
- 6. Families are encouraged to check the Burlington Gymnastics Club voicemail and website often as conditions may change throughout the day/notification period.
- If there are two (2) or more unforeseen closures during a recreational session
  the Burlington Gymnastics Club will apply a credit for the cancelled classes on the family
  account.
